## Garfield County Board of Commissioners Record

Burwell, Garfield County, Nebraska

The Garfield County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, April 9th, 2019 at 1:30 p.m. in the Commissioners Room at the Garfield County Courthouse in Burwell, Nebraska pursuant to public notice posted in three public places & broadcast by KNLV Radio, Ord, NE. Chairman Krause called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm with the following present:

Commissioners, Krause, Hurlburt, and Jeffres.

Motion made by Jeffres to approve the agenda, second by Krause. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Motion made by Jeffres to approve & adopt minutes of last County Commissioners meeting held March 26, 2019, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Motion made by Hurlburt to authorize the County Clerk to obtain the services of a draftsman to draw plans for the Courthouse restrooms, second by Jeffres. Aye, all; Nay, none.

In other unfinished business, the issue of amending the handbook to adjust the compensatory hours for employees. Motion made by Jeffres to adjust to 80 hours compensatory time, except more can be accumulated in emergency situations with the approval of Department head and the County Board, second by Krause. Aye, all; Nay, none.

The draft plan submitted by Central Sandhills Community Wildfire Protection Plan was reviewed.

Kali Swett, Planning and Zoning Administrator presented with a Minor Subdivision for Mike Scott. Motion made by Krause to approve, second by Jeffres. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Dale Crandall, County Attorney, submitted a request for authorization for appointment of Deputy Attorney to act on the behalf of the County when the County Attorney is unavailable due to absence, illness, disability or conflict of interest on a part-time, as-needed basis. Motion made by Krause to authorize the appointment with a resolution to be signed at the next Board meeting, second by Jeffres. Aye, all; Nay, none.

The monthly reports submitted by the County Treasurer and Clerk of the District Court were reviewed.

Gary Kinney, County Road Superintendent, presented with information on the road department and the current road conditions. He recently attended the FEMA briefing in Grand Island. Kinney also updated the Board on the Goff Bridge and it will be on hold due to the recent flood disaster.

Motion made by Jeffres to extend overtime payments to the Road department employees to the end of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, second by Krause. Aye, all; Nay, none.

With no further business, Chairman Krause adjourned the meeting at 2:25 p.m.
