Garfield County Board of Commissioners Record

Burwell, Garfield County, Nebraska

The Garfield County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, November 12th, 2019 at 1:30 p.m. in the Commissioners Room at the Garfield County Courthouse in Burwell, Nebraska pursuant to public notice posted in three public places & broadcast by KNLV Radio, Ord, NE. Chairman Krause called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm with the following present: Commissioners, Krause, Hurlburt and Jeffres.

Motion by Jeffres to approve the agenda, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Motion by Hurlburt to approve & adopt minutes of last County Commissioner meeting held October 22, 2019, second by Jeffres. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Road Superintendent, Gary Kinney, stated that he is still waiting on the hydraulic study to be complete on the Zulkoski culvert.

The Treasurer and Clerk of the District Court monthly reports reviewed as presented.

Road Superintendent, Gary Kinney, presented with information on the Road Department. He stated that the Cedar River Road project has been completed. Also, Kinney stated that the Kizer bridge has been ordered closed and will be placed on the County bridge replacement program.

County Treasurer, Linda Thoene, presented with a distress warrant report.

Planning and Zoning Administrator, Kali Swett, presented the Board with the Findings of Facts, minutes and applications for both conditional use permits scheduled for public hearing.

At 2:00 p.m., Chairman Krause opened the public hearing for the conditional use permit-private recreational use for Darin and Alicia Beavers. Public comments given and testimonies heard. At 2:10 p.m., Chairman Krause closed the public hearing and reconvened the regular meeting. Motion made by Jeffres to approve the conditional use permit with no conditions set, second by Hurlburt. Aye, Jeffres and Hurlburt; Nay, none; Abstained, Krause.

At 2:15 p.m., Chairman Krause opened the public hearing for the conditional use permit-private recreational use for Steve and Val Lytle. Public comments given and testimonies heard. At 2:20 p.m., Chairman Krause closed the public hearing and reconvened the regular meeting. Motion made by Jeffres to approve the conditional use permit with no conditions set, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Commissioner Hurlburt stated that during the recent safety committee meeting, the matter of safety in the parking lot at the library was discussed and recommend the matter be placed on the next meeting agenda.

With no further business, Chairman Krause adjourned the meeting at 2:30 p.m.
