## Garfield County Board of Commissioners Record

Burwell, Garfield County, Nebraska

The Garfield County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, April 13th, 2021 at 1:30 p.m. in the Commissioners Room at the Garfield County Courthouse in Burwell, Nebraska pursuant to public notice posted in three public places & broadcast by KNLV Radio, Ord, NE. Chairman Krause called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. with the following present: Commissioners, Krause, Hurlburt and Jeffres.

Motion made by Jeffres to approve the agenda, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Motion made by Krause to approve & adopt minutes of last County Commissioners meeting held March 23, 2021, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay none.

Motion made by Krause to approve & adopt minutes of the Special Board meeting held on April 5, 2021, second by Jeffres. Aye, all; Nay, none.

The Treasurer monthly revenue report was reviewed as presented along with the monthly District Court report for March and the Sheriff quarterly reports were reviewed.

Motion made by Krause to approve the professional service/consultant agreement for the CDBG 20-TF-002 tourism project between Garfield County and Olsson, Inc., second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Discussion was held about the replacement County vehicle and estimates were reviewed. Motion made by Hurlburt to proceed with the purchase of the Jeep from ADJR with the trade-in offer received, second by Krause. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Discussion was held about adopting a resolution designating Garfield County as a second amendment sanctuary county. Several Counties in the State of Nebraska have already approved and adopted similar resolutions. Motion made by Krause to designate Garfield County as a Second Amendment Sanctuary County, second by Jeffres. Aye, all; Nay, none. Motion was made by Krause to have County Attorney draft a resolution declaring Garfield County as a sanctuary county and have ready at the next regular meeting. Motion failed. The matter was tabled until the next regular meeting.

Gary Kinney, County Road Superintendent, presented with information about the completion of the north well. Discussion was held about the need to hire an excavator for repairs needed at the Swett bridge to fix a channel that created by the 2019 flood.

With no further business, Chairman Krause adjourned the meeting at 2:20 p.m.
