Garfield County Board of Commissioners Record

Burwell, Garfield County, Nebraska

The Garfield County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, January 25th, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. in the Commissioners Room at the Garfield County Courthouse in Burwell, Nebraska pursuant to public notice posted in three public places & broadcast by KNLV Radio, Ord, NE. Chairman Krause called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. with the following present: Commissioners, Krause and Hurlburt with Jeffres arriving at 1:45p.m..

Motion made by Krause to approve the agenda, second by Hurlburt. Aye, Krause and Hurlburt, Nay, none; Absent, Jeffres.

Motion made by Hurlburt to approve & adopt minutes of last County Commissioners meeting held January 11th, 2022, second by Krause. Aye, Krause and Hurlburt; Nay, none; Absent, Jeffres.

At 1:35 p.m., Chairman Krause recessed the regular meeting and opened the Board of Equalization. County Assessor, Kali Bolli, presented with Tax List Corrections #557. Motion made by Hurlburt to approve the tax list correction as presented, second by Krause. Aye, Krause and Hurlburt; Nay, none; Absent, Jeffres. At 1:36 p.m., Chairman Krause reconvened he regular meeting.

Motion made by Krause to approve the claims and payroll requested for the month of January 2022, second by Hurlburt. Aye, Krause and Hurlburt; Nay, none; Absent, Jeffres.

Motion made by Hurlburt to approve the appointments of for new 3 year terms to the Burwell Convention and Visitors Bureau Board for Marissa Amos, Johanna Jeffres and Marci Thoene, second by Krause. Aye, Krause and Hurlburt, Nay, none; Absent, Jeffres.

Gary Kinney, County Road Superintendent, presented with information on the bridges selected for the County Bridge Match Program, he stated that only 38/134 bridges in the state were selected. Kinney also reported that he hired a new employee to begin February 14, 2022 with the requirement to obtain CDL.

To remain in compliance with State Statute 35-901, the Burwell Volunteer Fire Department is asking the Garfield County Board of Commissioners, who is the taxing authority, for authorization to bill for ambulance services in 2022. Motion made by Jeffres to approve, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none.

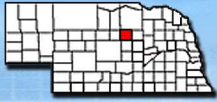
Hurlburt shared information pertaining to LB1194; appropriate federal funds to the Public Service Commission for public safety answering points and cloud-based software services to process 911 emergency calls.

Hurlburt also shared information about the overview of the final rule of Coronavirus State/Local fiscal recovery funds.

It was stated that Garfield County District Court case CI 19-6 Hughes v. Garfield County has been dismissed without prejudice and it would not be necessary to enter into closed session.

Motion made by Krause at 2:25 p.m. to go into closed session for the purpose of discussing Garfield County District Court case CI 18-2 Weber v. Garfield County, second by Jeffres. Those in attendance of closed session were members of the Board, County Attorney Crandall and Zoning Administrator Bolli. At 2:45 p.m., Chairman Krause reconvened the regular meeting with no action taken as a result of the closed session.

Chairman Krause adjourned the meeting at 2:50 p.m.
