



# Garfield County Board Minutes



## Garfield County Board of Commissioners Record

Burwell, Garfield County, Nebraska

The Garfield County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, August 9th, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. in the Commissioners Room at the Garfield County Courthouse in Burwell, Nebraska pursuant to public notice posted in three public places & broadcast by KNLV Radio, Ord, NE. Chairman Krause called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. with the following present: Commissioners, Krause, Hurlburt and Jeffres.

Motion made by Hurlburt to approve the agenda, second by Jeffres. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Motion made by Krause to approve & adopt minutes of last County Commissioners meeting held July 26th, 2022, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Krause directed the meeting to unfinished business. The matter of Fiscal Year 2022-2023 budget was discussed. In accordance with LB 644, discussion was held about the possibility of needing to hold a joint public hearing and the need for trimming the proposed budgets to reduce the levy increase.

Gary Kinney, County Road Superintendent, presented with information and updates on the road department. Kinney stated that final funds were received from NEMA for the Cedar River Road project.

Nate Lowe presented the Board with a request to add Keno Lottery to the regular General Election in November. Discussion was held about the logistics of the game and what the revenue would possibly look like and how it could possibly help alleviate the tax burden. Information was presented by Mike from the Department of Revenue via telephone. Motion made by Krause to proceed with adopting a resolution at the next regular meeting to certify the special issue to be included on the general election ballot, second by Jeffres. Aye, Krause and Jeffres; Nay, Hurlburt. Motion carried.

County Treasurer, Tammy Hitchcock, presented with July monthly revenue and disbursement reports along with a change in pledged collateral.

The Clerk of the District Court month end report for July was reviewed as presented.

Kali Bolli, Planning and Zoning Administrator, presented with a minor subdivision for Homestead Knolls. Motion made by Jeffres to approve the minor subdivision as presented, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none. Also presented was minor subdivision for Keith Beierman. Motion made by Krause to approve the subdivision as presented, second by Jeffres. Aye, all; Nay, none. A final presentation of a plat approval for Dennis & Nicole Michael. Motion made by Krause to approve the plat as presented, second by Jeffres. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Hurlburt presented with information on the NACO (National Association of County Officials) annual conference that she recently attended in Colorado. Hurlburt stated that she is now on the National Transportation Board.

Motion made by Jeffres to enter into a closed session for the purpose of discussing matters pertaining to District Court case CI 18-2 Weber v. Garfield County, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none. At 2:57 p.m., Chairman Krause cleared the room for the closed session. Those present for the closed session were members of the Board and County Attorney Crandall. At 3:35 p.m. Chairman Krause reconvened the regular meeting. No action was taken by the Board.

With no further business, Chairman Krause adjourned the meeting at 3:40 p.m.
