The Garfield County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, September 13th, 2022 at 1:05 p.m. in the Commissioners Room at the Garfield County Courthouse in Burwell, Nebraska, pursuant to public notice posted in the Burwell Tribune with the following present: Commissioners, Krause, Jeffres and Hurlburt. At 1:05 p.m., Chairman Krause opened the Budget Hearing. The 2022-2023 fiscal year budget was presented by Donald O. Nelson, CPA. With no comments from the public, at 1:19 p.m., Chairman Krause closed the Budget Hearing. At 1:20 p.m., Chairman Krause opened the Final Tax Request Hearing. Information was presented by Donald O. Nelson, CPA.. At 1:29 p.m. Chairman Krause closed the Final Tax Request Hearing.

The Garfield County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, September 13th, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. in the Commissioners Room at the Garfield County Courthouse in Burwell, Nebraska pursuant to public notice posted in three public places. Chairman Krause called the regular meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. with the following present: Commissioners, Krause, Hurlburt and Jeffres.

Motion made by Jeffres to approve the agenda, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Motion made by Krause to approve & adopt minutes of last County Commissioners meeting held August 23rd, 2022, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none.

In unfinished business, Hurlburt inquired about the upcoming Industrial Review Hearing that is scheduled for September 27, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. and wanted to know if there was anything to do prior to the hearing. County Attorney, Dale Crandall, stated that the hearing is the review.

Resolution 2022-17; County Budget for Fiscal Year July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023, prepared by the Budget Making Authority on the 13th day of September, 2022. Motion made by Jeffres to approve Resolution 2022-17, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none.

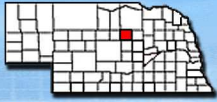
Resolution 2022-18; Whereas the Nebraska Revised State Statute 77-1632 and 77-1633 provides that the property tax request for the prior year shall be the property tax request for the current year for purposes of the levy set by the County Board of Equalization unless the Governing Body of the Garfield County Board of Commissioners passes, by a majority vote, a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request at a different amount, The Governing Body of Garfield, by majority vote, resolves that the 2022-2023 property tax be set at \$1,315,235.00. Motion made by Hurlburt to approve Resolution 2022-18, second by Jeffres. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Hurlburt presented with concerns that she received from a resident on 466th Ave south of Highway 91 about the traffic going by his residence and requested an advisory speed sign to be placed on the road. Road Superintendent, Gary Kinney, suggested that they could post an advisory sign and see if that helps.

Kinney presented with information on the proposed Viaero Fiber Route along with a proposed agreement. The Board suggested a few minor changes on the agreement before approved. Kinney also presented with information on various road projects and a proposed interlocal agreement between Garfield County and North Loup River Public Power and Irrigation District for Burwell Southwest, C36(116) structure no. C003600305. Motion made by Hurlburt to approve the interlocal agreement as presented, second by Krause. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Motion made by Krause to approve the ADA Policy and Assurances for Garfield County, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none.

County Treasurer, Tammy Hitchcock, presented with a change in pledged collateral along with the monthly revenue report and disbursement report for August.
