Garfield County Board of Commissioners Record

The Garfield County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, December 27th, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. in the Commissioners Room at the Garfield County Courthouse in Burwell, Nebraska pursuant to public notice posted in three public places. Chairman Krause called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. with the following present: Commissioners, Krause, Hurlburt and Jeffres.

Motion made by Jeffres to approve the agenda, second by Hurlburt. Aye, all; Nay, none.

Motion made by Hurlburt to approve & adopt minutes of last County Commissioners meeting held December 13th, 2022, second by Jeffres. Aye, all; Nay, none.

County Sheriff, Korey Johnson, presented with information on the purchase of a new law enforcement vehicle for potential new law enforcement personnel. Discussion was held on what options were available through the state bidding. Motion made by Hurlburt to utilize ARPA funds to purchase a new vehicle for the Sheriff Department, second by Krause. Chuck and Amy Cassidy, representing Longhorn Lanes of Burwell, expressed to the board an interest in having Keno at Longhorn Lanes. No decision was made on how to proceed with the operators. Chairman Krause noted that the item be placed on the next agenda.

Motion made by Hurlburt to approve payroll and claims submitted for payment for the month of December.

Motion made by Hurlburt to enter a closed session to discuss personnel issues, second by Krause. Aye, all; Nay, none. At 2:25 p.m., Chairman Krause cleared the room for the closed session. Those in attendance of the closed session were members of the Board, County Clerk Koenigsberg and County Treasurer Hitchcock. Chairman Krause reconvened the regular meeting at 2:55 p.m. with no action taken as a result of the closed session.
