

Garfield County Board of Commissioners Record

Burwell, Garfield County, Nebraska

The Garfield County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, February 10, 2026, at 1:30 p.m. in the Commissioners Room at the Garfield County Courthouse in Burwell, Nebraska pursuant to public notice posted in three public places. Chairman Hurlburt called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. with the following present: Commissioners, Hurlburt, Zulkoski, and Krause.

Motion made by Zulkoski to approve the agenda, second by Krause. Roll call vote: Aye, all; Nay, none.

Motion made by Krause to approve & adopt minutes of last County Commissioners meeting held January 27, 2026, second by Zulkoski. Roll call vote: Aye, all; Nay, none.

Chairman Hurlburt directed the meeting to public comments, with no comments heard.

Clinton Olcott was present to discuss safety concerns on the 4M blacktop road and to ask what the plan was for the road to repair or resurface as the condition is not good. Discussion held on the current conditions and work being done on the road. Can post a sign for thru traffic alert and Kinney stated he will investigate some options. Item to be added to next meeting agenda.

Gary Kinney, County Road Superintendent, presented information on the road department. Kinney stated that he found a flatbed trailer to purchase for \$14,000. Kinney also presented information on the Cedar River Road Project and stated the project is set to be complete in 2029. Chairman Hurlburt addressed the concerns from residents about the recent tree removal on 474th Ave in the eastern part of the County and asked that Kinney review the process and clean up the road after the work has been done.

The monthly revenue report for January and disbursement report along with a change in pledged collateral was reviewed, as presented. County Treasurer, Tammy Hitchcock, also presented with the delinquent tax sale notice.

The District Court month end report for January was reviewed as presented.

A general assistance application was reviewed as presented. Motion made by Hurlburt to approve the request for general assistance, second by Krause. Roll call vote: Aye, all; Nay, none.

A proposed updated interlocal agreement between Region 26 and Garfield County was reviewed.

A letter of support for Housing for the 21st Century was signed by the board to be submitted to US Representative Adrian Smith.

Motion made by Zulkoski to adjourn the meeting, second by Krause. With no further business, Chairman Hurlburt adjourned the meeting at 2:55 p.m.
