

## **Garfield County Board of Commissioners Record**

Burwell, Garfield County, Nebraska

The Garfield County Board of Commissioners met Tuesday, February 24, 2026, at 1:30 p.m. in the Commissioners Room at the Garfield County Courthouse in Burwell, Nebraska, pursuant to public notice posted in three public places. Chairman Hurlburt called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. Present were Commissioners Hurlburt, Zulkoski, and Krause. Chairman Hurlburt noted the placement of the Open Meetings Act on the west wall of the Commissioners' Chambers and led those present in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion made by Hurlburt to approve the agenda with the addition of the courthouse hours on February 26, 2026, second by Krause. Roll call vote: Aye, all; Nay, none.

Motion made by Zulkoski to approve & adopt minutes of last County Commissioners meeting held February 10, 2026, second by Hurlburt. Roll call vote: Aye, all; Nay, none.

No public comments.

Gary Kinney, County Road Superintendent, presented information on the road department. Kinney reported on the road guys plowing snow in the recent snowstorm anywhere from 3-8 inches of snow in the county. Reported on patching the 4M and Johnson roads when the weather was still warm and will continue when the weather warms up again in the near future.

At 1:35 p.m. Chairman Hurlburt recessed the regular meeting and opened the Board of Equalization. Kali Bolli, County Assessor, presented with tax list corrections 595, 596, 597, and 598. Motion made by Krause to approve the tax list corrections as presented, second by Zulkoski. Roll call vote: Aye, all; Nay, none. At 1:37 p.m., Chairman Hurlburt closed the Board of Equalization and reconvened the regular meeting.

Kali Bolli, County Assessor, presented with contracts from Vanguard. Motion made by Krause to approve the consolidated extended service contract for three years and the archive module contract for six years with Vanguard, second by Zulkoski. Roll call vote: Aya, all; Nay, none.

Chairman Hurlburt recessed the regular meeting and entered the public hearing at 1:45 p.m. for the purpose of approving a permit for the dredging and mining of sand and gravel for Jeffres Sand and Gravel. Kali Bolli, Zoning Administrator, presented with a statement of findings of fact from the Garfield County Planning and Zoning Board. Lee Jeffres representing Jeffres Sand and Gravel was present to offer information. Chairman Hurlburt closed the public hearing at 1:49 p.m. and reconvened the regular meeting. Motion made by Hurlburt to approve the conditional use permit for the dredging and mining of sand and gravel with no conditions, second by Zulkoski. Roll call vote: Aye, all; Nay, none.

Motion made by Zulkoski to approve the payroll and claims for February, second by Hurlburt. Roll call vote: Aye, all; Nay, none.

The courthouse hours for Thursday, February 26, 2026, were discussed. There is a planned power outage scheduled for the City of Burwell that will affect the courthouse. Motion made by Hurlburt to set the service hours for February 26, 2026, 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m., second by Krause. Roll call vote: Aye, all; Nay, none.

Motion made by Zulkoski to adjourn the meeting, second by Krause. With no further business, Chairman Hurlburt adjourned the meeting at 2:04 p.m.
